RECEPTION PLANNING FOR THURSDAY 2nd MARCH 2020

Morning everyone,

You will be pleased to know there is now a **Reception playlist** connected to our Calpe Youtube channel. Check out my first video using the link <u>https://youtu.be/K8VkP6NlymY</u> I hope you enjoy it. I will be adding more videos of me reading the story of the week, reviewing our sounds using the Floppy Phonics software, playing maths games and explaining the activities too.

Today we will be continuing to think about the life cycle of ducks and we will be finding one less than numbers to 20 using our number cards.

Activities to complete today:

Literacy

- Watch the video of me reading the story 'Brenda's boring egg' <u>https://youtu.be/rvr1IQwat3c</u> (It can also be found in Thursday's folder)
- Find the 'My Exciting egg' sheet in Thursday's folder (or draw your own egg)
- Draw something really exciting that you would like to find in your egg.
- Write what you have drawn on the line at the bottom.
- Decorate the egg to make it look really exciting!

<u>Maths</u>

For the Maths activities this week you will need to make 2 sets of number cards (numbers 1 to 20) - these can be found in Monday's folder or you can make your own.

You need 1 set of number cards. (1 -20)

- Lay the number cards along the floor.
- Ask your child to jump next to each number as you count to 20 and back together.
- Ask them to choose any number from 1 to 19 and stand next to it.
- Ask them to say what number they are on and *what is one less than this number?* (*What is the number behind it?*) Encourage them to answer before allowing them to jump back one to the number before.
- Remind them that for one less we jump backwards along the number line <



• Repeat starting on different numbers each time.

Extra:

- Play the '**Quick recognise'** game hold one number card up at a time for your child to say the number. Time them and see if they can beat their time and say them quicker next time.
- Next hold up a number card and the child says which number is **one less than** the number on the card.

Phonics

- Watch the Floppy's phonics video reviewing the 'ai' sound using the link <u>https://youtu.be/3e27PwwfMjA</u>
- Encourage your child to join in with the video to talk about what they can see, blend the words to read them, count the sounds in the words, suggest the sounds needed to build the words and do the actions for each sound.

Extra:

• Play a tricky word game (see the list of games found in the OneDrive folder)

Fine Motor Development (Busy Fingers)

- Complete the 'Egg pencil control activity sheets' (found in Thursday's folder)
- Trace over the dotted lines slowly and carefully.
- Then colour the eggs in to make them look beautiful.

Extra:

- Practice writing your name.
- Remember the first letter is a capital letter and the rest are small letters.
- Draw a straight line to sit your letters on neatly.


Reading books

- Log onto <u>www.activelearnprimary.co.uk</u>
- Find your allocated reading book and read it to an adult or older sibling.

Remember to click on the little bug icon on the last page of the story to answer a question from the story.



Answer the question and then press 'Done'





The bee will say "Fantastic, lets go back to the book" Press 'OK' Then press the open book.

You will see that the bug will close his eyes and the circle turns grey. This means you have completed the book.
