Using Class Dojo as an online learning platform




- You should have all received an email with instructions for how to access a **new school email address** that we have created for you within the Calpe School G suites account.

- A **guide** will also be sent to you for how to use Class Dojo to access work, videos and resources; and how to communicate directly with me via an instant messaging facility.


Activities to complete today:

<u>Maths</u>

For the Maths activities this week you will need use the number cards you made previously (numbers 1 – 10)

- The numbers that can't be shared fairly are called 'odd' numbers.

Pirate hat

- Stick the hat cut out to the head band.

Pirate flag
