Today I would like you to design and create a **Fun Day** in your houses and/or gardens! With this task, I am looking for you to try to complete as many of the following, or if you can think of some extra things yourself, go ahead:

- A **poster** with beautiful clear handwriting and drawings. What will be included your fun day? How much money does it cost to come inside? Do you have any games? What are the prizes? Remember the date and time for you fun day.
- Create a **timetable** of what will happen at different times – will there be a show or a dance? Will there be time for food and drink?
- Create a **Menu** for the food and drink stand. People always want healthy snacks and drinks when they are having fun. What will there be? Remember to think of how much each item will cost and when if you need to prepare and cut any snacks in half, make sure they are the same sizes!
- Design a fun **obstacle course** around your garden or in your house – think of challenges people need to do like: jump over things (carefully), spin around 3 times, do 5 star jumps, stand on one leg and count to 10 in 2s. Draw a **map** of what it will look like.
- **Make a den**, to create some shade and somewhere to have some peace and quiet to relax.

- Create a **dance** that people can then copy along later in the day. Make sure to practise it plenty of times, so that you know it well.
- Create an **Art show**, explaining how to draw some of the animals from yesterday's work. Become a fun teacher!
- Create a show showing your **talent**: rugby skills, hip hop moves, magic tricks, singing, anything you enjoy!
- At the end of the day, **tidy up!**
- Then finally, **write about your Fun Day**. What went well? What did you enjoy the most? Ask your family – what did they enjoy?
- Please write 5-10 sentences sharing everything with me and remember to share some pictures and videos with me! I wish I could come join in with your fun day activities!
