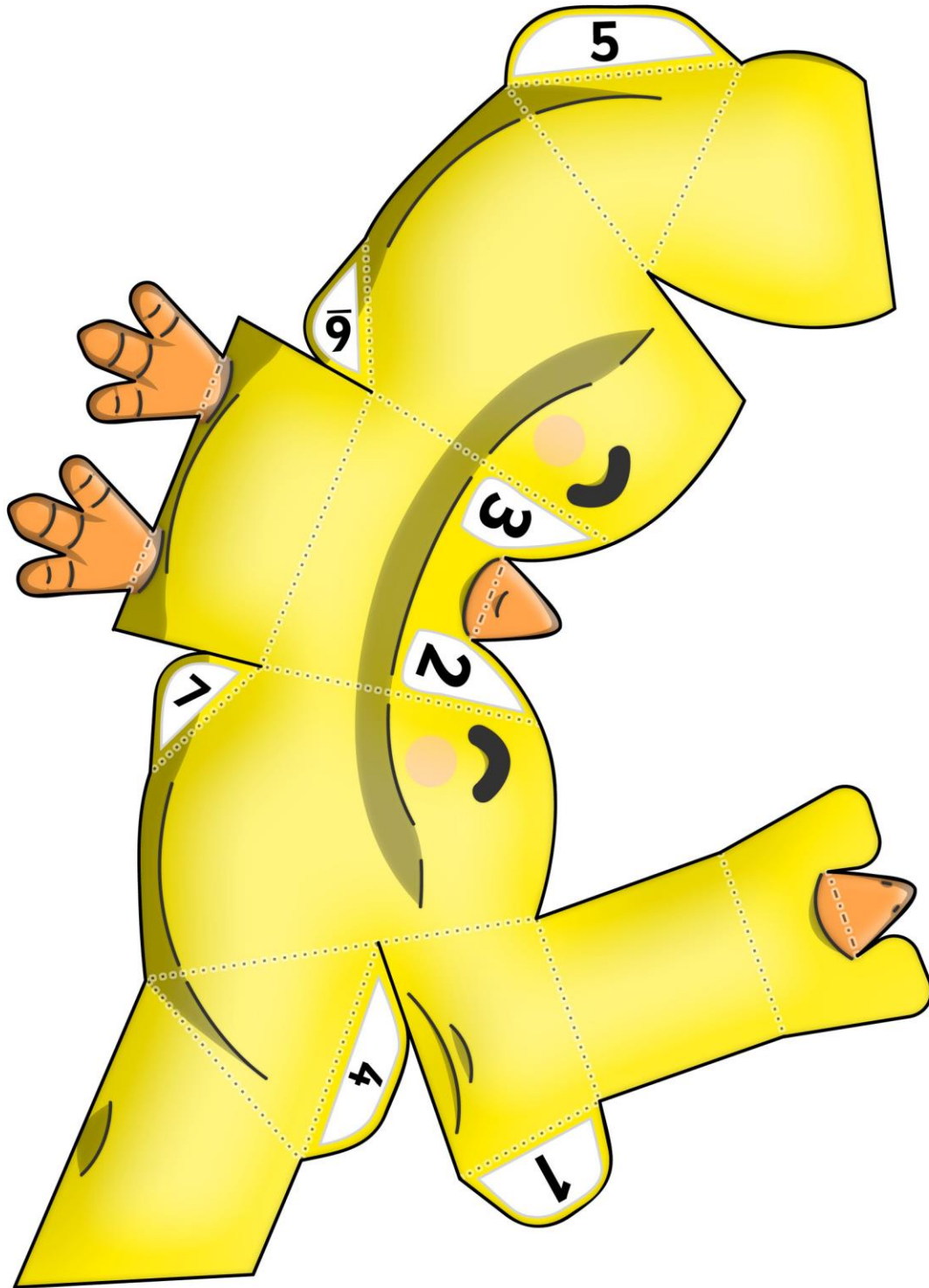

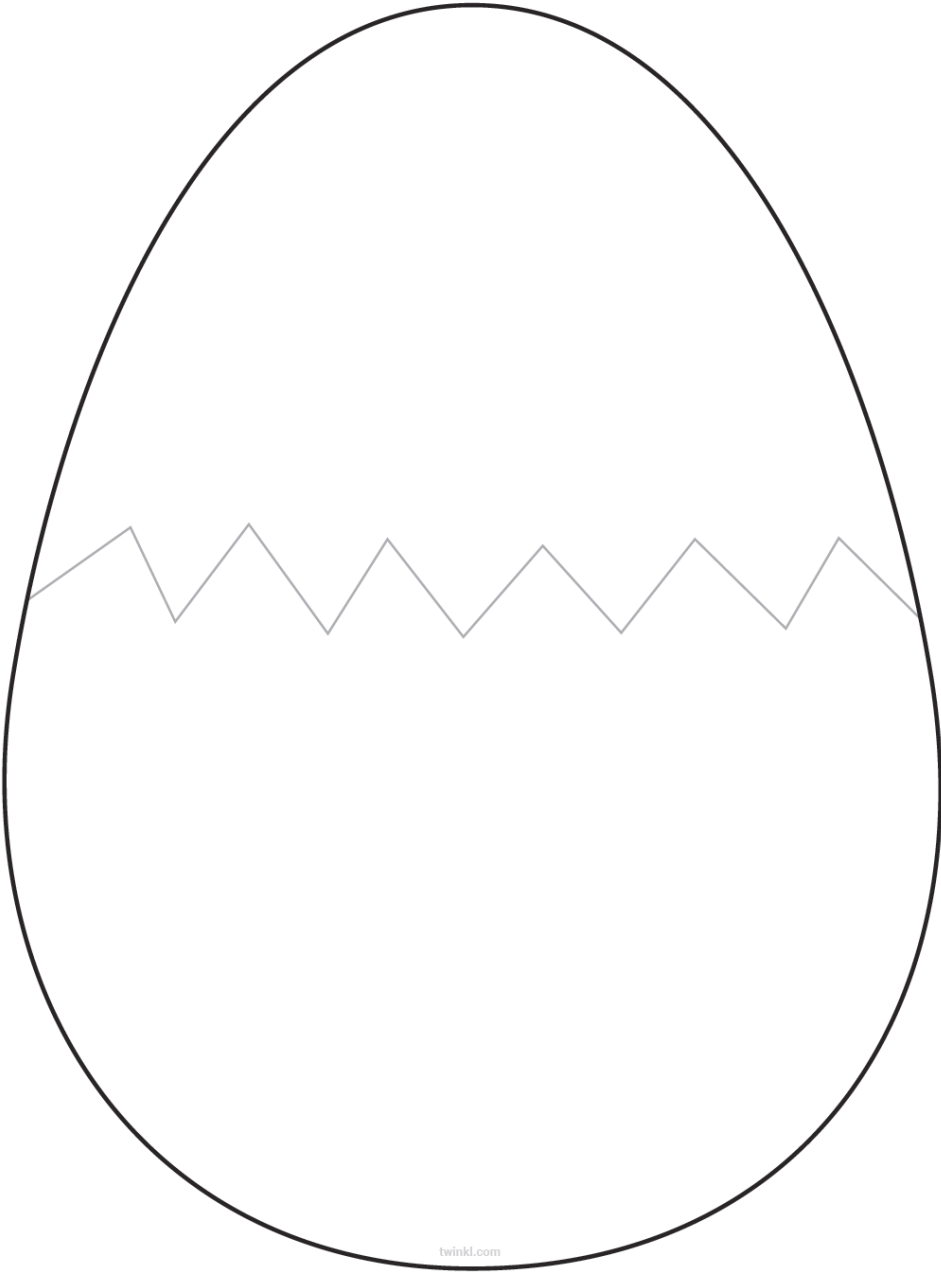
Easter Chick Paper Model

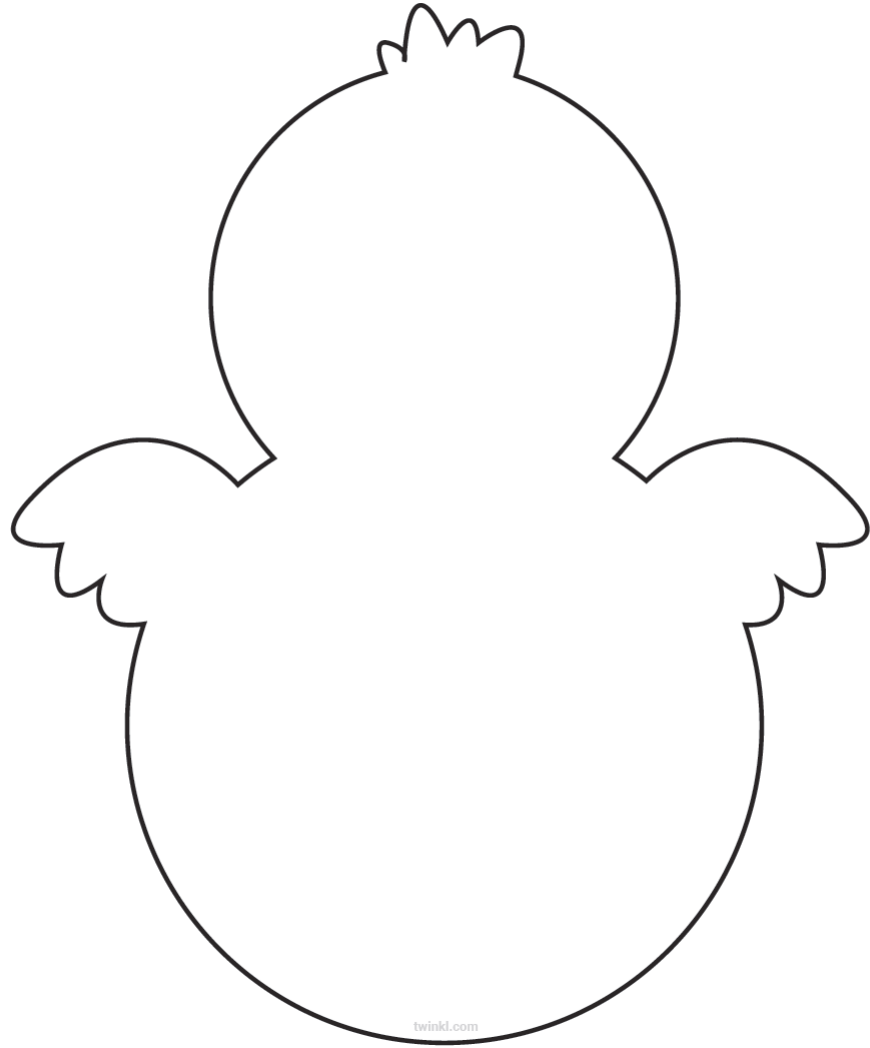

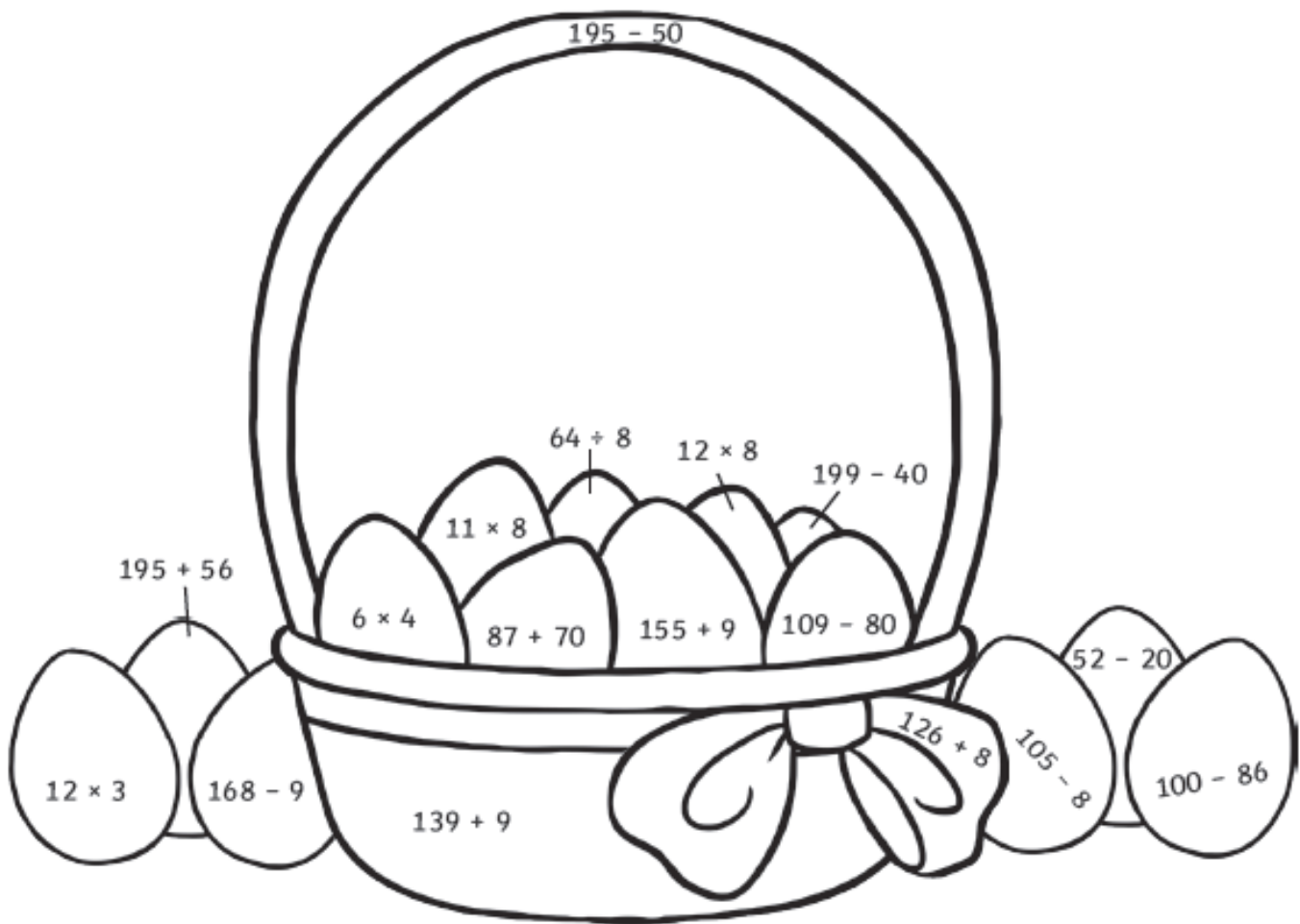
