**Aim: To calculate the missing angle in a straight line, triangles or a full turn**

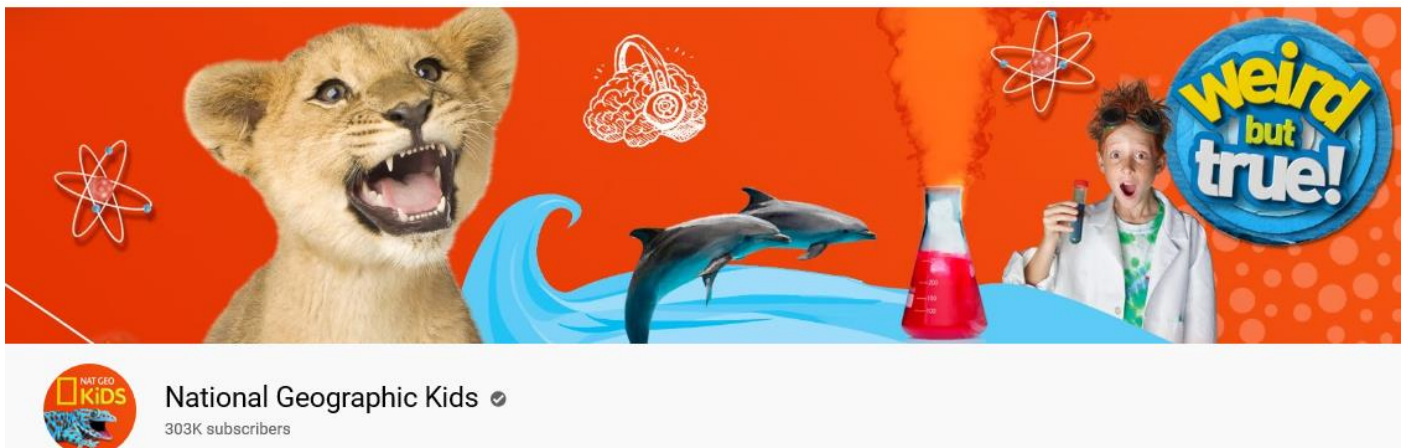
