I thought we would have a rainbow day today - remember the deadline for the rainbow picture competition is this Friday.


Below are some more rainbow activities to inspire you!

Find the Elmer colouring sheet in Monday's folder using the link above.


Colour the patchwork on Elmer to make him look as bright and colourful as you can.

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Make a rainbow spinner

- Find the spinner template in Monday's folder.
- Colour the segments in the circle the seven colours of the rainbow.
- Stick the circle onto a piece of card (from a cereal box for example) and cut it out.
- Make two holes in the centre of the card 1 cm. apart and thread some string through them making a loop at each end.. Put a finger through the end of each loop and flip the disc over the string several times until the string is well twisted. Pull your hands apart and let the string go slack. The disc should now spin.
- Or push a pencil through the middle to make a spinning top.
