Literacy

- Read the 'The Enormous Turnip story power point' (found in the OneDrive folder from the link above, under Friday 20th March).
- Ask your child how the farmer grew the enormous turnip. Go back to slide 3 of the power point and show them the turnip seed packet.
- Print the 'seed packet template' (found in Friday's folder) or draw your own.
- Help your child to cut it out and then fold and glue the flaps together to make a seed packet.
- Your child can then draw a turnip on the front (see the turnip photos in Friday's folder.
 Then help them to spell *Turnip Seeds*.
 Sound the words out slowly: t- ur (as in purse) n-i-p s-ee (as in eel) d-s.
- On the back they can draw what plants need to grow –sunlight, water, soil and air

Maths

- Play the ordinal numbers game using the web link below
- Start with 'Sports Day' read the sentences and move the runners in the correct positions
