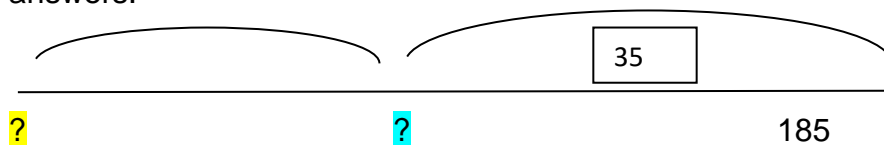
Aim: To subtract by using the counting up method

This is another page of subtractions by counting up. You should be able to do this well but if you are stuck, use Pupil Video 3.9 and 3.19 or the Counting up tool (Frog) TT 31.

Remember that frog uses multiples of 10 or 100 to jump on. This makes it easy to calculate mentally.

THINK optional

Draw a frog line. The end number is 185. Frog did a jump of 35 so subtract 35. Your answer should be a multiple of 10 (?). What number might have frog started on (?). It would be before ? and not a multiple of 10. There are many possible answers.



Literacy

Aim: To plan a Non-Fiction report

As you know since we discussed this in class multiple times, after reading our eBook Let's Go To..., our aim is to write a Non-Fiction text and answer the Big Question 'Where would you like to live?' You must decide where you would like to live from the countries listed in the book: United Kingdom, United States of America, France, Australia, Kenya, Japan or Brazil. Your report must give facts to support your opinion. Today you will start planning your ideas for your text.

Here is a reminder of what your text will include:

- Index
- Contents page
- Headings
- Subheadings
- Pictures (photos, illustrations)
- Labels
- Captions
- Facts to support your opinions
- Vocabulary related to topic
- Present tense
- Usually third person, but sometimes first person
- Text organised into paragraphs
- Non-chronological

Look at the provided Report Writing Checklist. Your job today is to do the first 4 steps and then fill-in your Report Plan. Read my example to get ideas.

The **title** can have an alliteration like in the eBook (**S**plendid **S**pain) or you can create your own idea as long as it's clear which country you chose or what your report is going to be about (for example, My Future Location)

The **introduction** must give the answer to the Big Question: Where would you like to live?

Each **paragraph** will explain why you chose that country. You can use the same headings as the eBook: At Home, At School, At Play, or you can think of your own 3 reasons why you chose that country and make up your own headings such as Lifestyle, Traditions, Food, Animals, Geography, etc. In your plan, think of 2 ideas per paragraph. You can write in bullet points rather than long sentences since this is just to organise your ideas.

The **conclusion** can say whether you really would like to live there one day when you are older for work, or move there with your family now, or just visit for a holiday.

Think of **topic-related** words you could use to improve your text such as currency, capital city, language, population.

Think of what **image** would complement your report well.

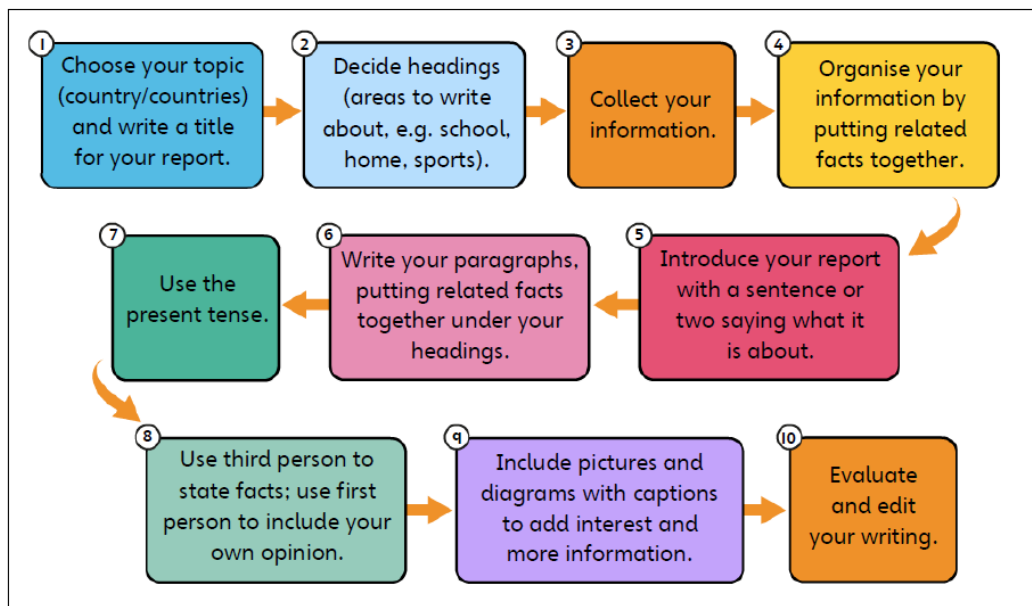
Frog jumps to the next 10 and then makes a jump of 35 to land on 185. What number did the Frog jump from?

This is an example of a plan for your report. Remember you must choose a country from the eBook. I chose one that isn't in the eBook as an example only.

Title: Tremendous Thailand	
Introduction After learning about 7 different countries, I have chosen to live in Thailand for many reasons that I will explain.	
First paragraph: At Home Main idea: Homes are near the beach	Details: Many tropical beaches and beautiful scenery
Second paragraph: At School Main idea: Learn a new language but possibility of going to a British school	Details: I already speak English, French and Spanish so I am good at languages
Third paragraph: At Play Main idea: Thai traditional dance, Festivals like Thai New Year	Details: I like to dance and learn new traditions
Conclusion I might really prefer staying in Spain but I could go to Thailand for a holiday when I am older.
