I hope you are all well. On Friday, those who were in school received a pack of work in a blue folder. I will refer to this folder over the next few weeks, in addition to games and activities on Active Learn. If you were not present on Friday, there are alternative tasks set on each point for you.

Please could you today:

1. Complete the first Phonics sheet. There is a photocopy of the page to help you with the sound. Try your best to remember sound buttons and create some sentences on the back, using all of the sounds. For those who did not receive the pack, please refer back to the 100 high frequency words (given before Christmas holidays). Please read them and write 5-10 sentences using as many of them as possible in each sentence.
2. Complete the digital and analogue clock worksheet. Some clocks have the digital time already there, please complete the analogue. There is also a game on Active learn if you cannot complete the worksheet about analogue clocks.
3. In your blue book you have the first page which has the Aim already written which is to write about an animal. If you don't have a blue book, please complete it on a separate piece of paper. I would like you to find an animal that ONLY lives in Europe. Can you draw it, label it, write about it - describe how it looks, what does it eat? is it a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore? is it a mammal, reptile, bird, insect, fish or amphibian?
4. Complete one page in your handwriting book. Remember the date on top.
5. Access Numbots on Active Learn to complete a few games (15 minutes). You will find it in the green link icon in 'my library' or in 'my stuff'.
