Literacy

- Read through the 'Growing Beans' power point and watch the 'Bean seed growing' video, both found in Thursday's folder in the OneDrive link.
- Talk about the different stages of the bean seed growing first the roots grow, then the shoot, stem, leaves, flowers and finally the bean pods.
- Find the 'Growing beans worksheet' you need pages 1 and 2 only (found in Thursday's folder).
- Cut and stick **or** draw the 4 pictures of the bean lifecycle in the correct order.
- Can you label each picture too? You can use the 'Life cycle of a bean display posters' found in Thursdays folder to help you.

Maths

- Play the ordinal numbers game using the web link below.

Phonics

- Play tricky word BINGO!
- Print a 'BINGO! board' for your child (or make one) and the 'BINGO word list' for the adult to read. (found in Thursday's folder)
- If other members of the family are playing print/make multiple BINGO boards.
- The adult reads one word at a time from the BINGO word list and the child (and other family members) looks for the word on their board, if they have it they then colour the square.
- When all their squares are coloured in they shout BINGO!
- Remember 'tricky words' cannot be sounded out but must be recognised by sight.

Fine Motor Development (Busy Fingers)

- Complete the 'What do plants need matching' sheet.
- Read each word and carefully draw a line to the correct picture.
- Then colour the pictures in using the correct colours.
