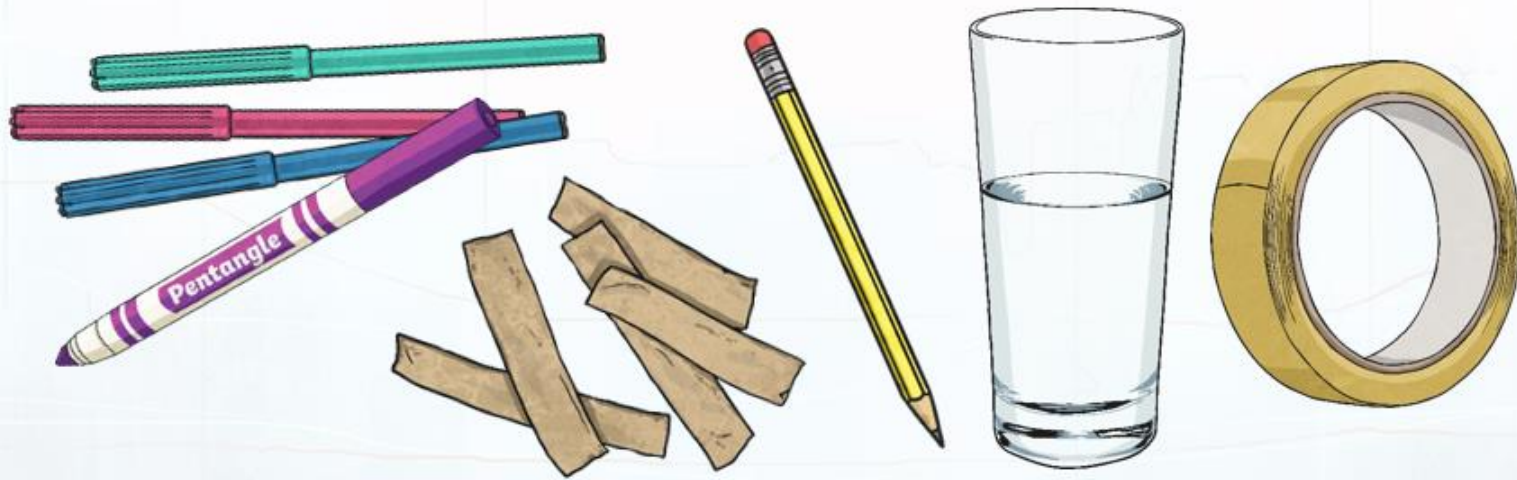
Here are some ideas to keep you busy. Pick and choose, as you wish:

You Will Need



- Felt tip markers of different colours (× 4)
- Coffee filter
- Lead pencil
- Cups
- Sticky tape

YOU CAN USE KITCHEN ROLL IF YOU DO NOT HAVE COFFEE FILTERS

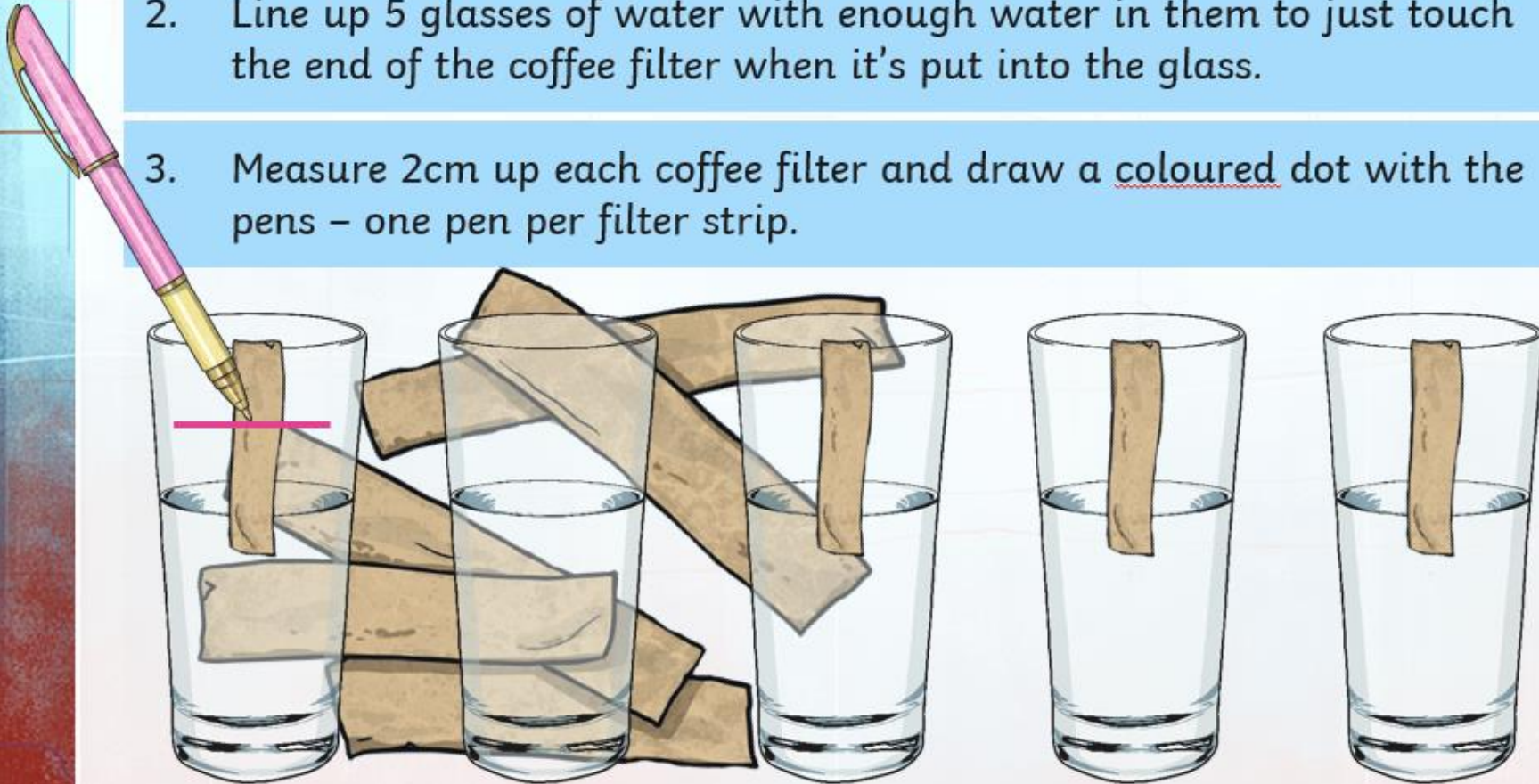
Coffee Filter Investigation

1. Cut a coffee filter into 5 strips.

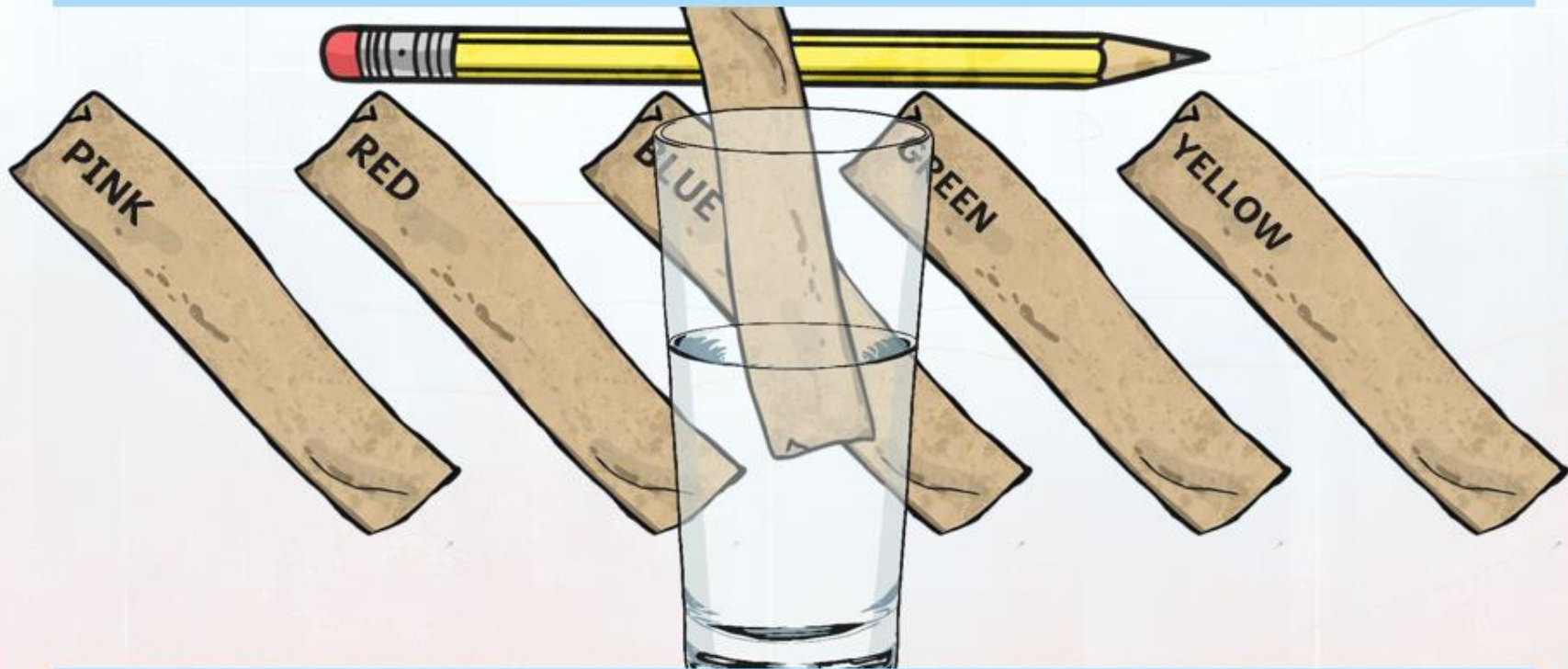
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2. Line up 5 glasses of water with enough water in them to just touch the end of the coffee filter when it's put into the glass.

3. Measure 2cm up each coffee filter and draw a coloured dot with the pens – one pen per filter strip.



4. In pencil, write the colour of pen which was on each strip on the other side of the strip so it will be identifiable later.
5. Loop the labelled side of the coffee filter around the middle of a pencil and attach with sticky tape.
6. Lay the pencil across the top of the glass of water so that the coffee filter is just touching the water.



7. Watch the water as it seeps up the filter.
